## FAMILY PLANNING: A KEY COMPONENT OF POST ABORTION CARE Consensus Statement (USAID – FIGO – ICM – ICN)

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## The need of "consensus statements"

- Heath issues, which have been controversial or where the proven solution is not applied in spite of the evidences.
- Women health and wellbeing is affected by the lack of action
- The prestige of the organization can help to move the providers to follow the recommendations

### **Examples of FIGO Statements**

- Mechanism of Action. How do levonorgestrel-only emergency contraceptive pills prevent pregnancy?
- MISOPROSTOL. 2012 Recommended
  Dosages
- Prevention of Post-partum hemorrhage
- Family planning: a key component of post abortion care (With ICM, ICN, USAID)


Why is post abortion family planning important?

 Unsafe abortion is one of the main causes of maternal death in developing countries where abortion is not legal

Maternal Mortality due to unsafe abortion **Depends on:** 1. The rate of induced abortion

# Abortion rate according to world region


#### Abortion/ 1000 women 15-44 years


### UNSAFE ABORTION RATE PER 1000 WOMEN 15-44 ACCORDING TO SUB-REGION (2003)

 Primary Prevention: Less unintended pregnancies and abortions

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 Secondary Prevention: Non preventable abortions should be safe

 Tertiary Prevention: Unsafe abortions do not complicate and kill the woman

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 Quaternary Prevention: Postabortion counseling and services to prevent repeated abortions

Supports the most important strategy aiming the prevention of unsafe abortion

 Every woman admitted for incomplete induced abortion is telling us she feels that she cannot have a (another) child

 All post-abortion women, including miscarriages, should receive voluntary post abortion family planning counseling.

 A wide range of contraceptive methods with emphasis, in long-acting and permanent methods, should be offered and accompanied by simple written instructions.

 Post abortion family planning uptake is high when quality services are offered before discharge.

 Provision of universal access to post abortion family planning should be a standard of practice for doctors, nurses, and midwives.
